

COVID 19- PATIENT TESTING/EXPOSURE

We are testing you for COVID-19 today, your results may take a week to come back. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

Fever or chills
Cough
Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
Fatigue
Muscle or body aches
Headache
New loss of taste or smell
Sore throat
Congestion or runny nose
Nausea or vomiting
Diarrhea

Look for emergency warning signs for COVID-19. If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:

Trouble breathing
Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
New confusion
Inability to wake or stay awake
Bluish lips or face

If you have symptoms or have a POSITIVE result-

Please follow at home instructions.

Wear a mask.

1. Stay at home, except to get essential medical care or basic needs, like food.
2. Avoid locations including work, school, or public areas, public transport, rideshare, or taxis.
3. Separate yourself from others in the home, as much as possible.
4. Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue or you elbow.
5. Wash your hands often with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.
6. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
7. Do not share household items like dishes, cups, eating utensils, and bedding.
8. Reschedule all non-essential medical appointments and call ahead to your medical provider before you for instructions or precautions needed prior to appointment.

9. Postpone long-distance travel as you may be unable to return if you become symptomatic.
10. Monitor your symptoms for 14 days after you were exposed. Watch for: fever (take your temperature twice a day), coughing, shortness of breath, body aches, sore throat, headache, diarrhea and/or vomiting.
